ADMISSION POLICY & PROCESS

ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-23

- Admissions open each year for class Nursery and limited vacancies in classes Prep to IX and XI. The entry class for admission is Nursery.
- Admission is subject to the availability of seats.
- The bulk admissions are done at Nursery level based on the Interaction with the child and interaction and the parents along with verification of documents.
- Admissions to classes above entry level is subject to the availability of seats in the concerned class, the performance of applicant children in written tests, and oral interactions with parents. Provisional admission granted to students in Class XI prior to declaration of Board exam results are confirmed on the basis of class X results declared by the CBSE.
- The application form (Offline/Online) can be collected from the Cambridge School office / Website on payment of Registration Fee.
- The application form duly completed in all respects and accompanied by necessary documents as mentioned in the application form should be submitted within the date mentioned on the website.
- The submission of an application form or its acceptance by the school office does not in any way guarantee admission.
- Appearing for an oral test, written test or interaction with the school staff and Principal does not guarantee admission to the school.
- All requisite admission formalities including payment of fees are required to be completed within 3 working days of the offer of admission.
- Students applying under the EWS category should get in touch with the DIOS, Noida (U.P.) as per applicable rules.
- Parents seeking withdrawal of their ward after payment of fees shall be eligible for reimbursement as follows:
 - If a child is withdrawn, prior to attending school only registration and admission fee will be deducted from fees paid and the rest refunded.
 - If a child is withdrawn after joining the school and attending class: parents may either serve one month's notice in writing or pay one month's fee (clear all dues) in lieu of thereof.
